


Installation

sudo apt-get install -y cockpit
```



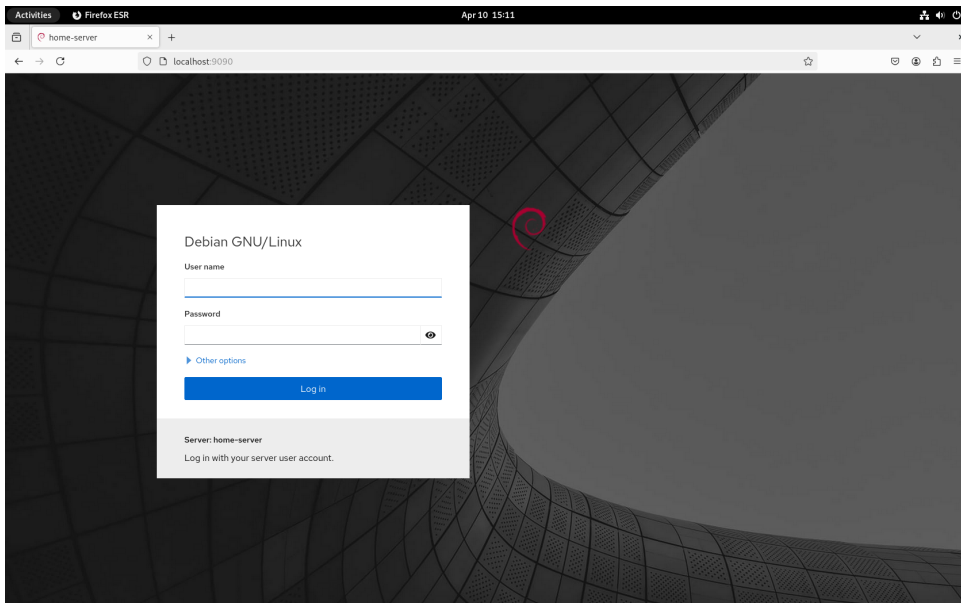
